

DESIGN CHALLENGE

To create short term activations and long-term design proposals for select sites along the Yellow Mill Corridor. Proposals should provide connectivity for the Bridgeport Waterfront Pathway; heal and protect the shoreline using nature-based solutions; and create a place for all Bridgeport community members to relax and enjoy the waterfront.





Biohabitats identified three locations that are conducive to strong greenway trail design along the Yellow Mill Channel. These sites are owned by the City of Bridgeport and offer opportunities to connect the public to the water and ecology of the site, and implement programming identified by the community during the December 2022 Waterfront Advisory Board meeting such as gazebos, plazas, and food vendors. While these elements are not the focus of this report, it is important to consider them as future context with the proposed green infrastructure interventions.









Vision Statement

Create a safe and sustainable waterfront community space that supports the well-being of locals and nearby ecosystems without displacing the MOVE Yacht Club.




























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


To serve the community around the channel and create a space, a "hidden gem", to be enjoyed by people of all ages and backgrounds



- Create a sense of "ownership"











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





VISION STATEMENT & PROJECT GOALS
